Cover image: The figure on the cover (from the American College of Rheumatology Slide Collection on the Rheumatic Diseases) shows osteoarthritis of the knees. The image on the left, the anteroposterior projection of the knee, shows marked narrowing of the medial compartment and moderate sclerosis of adjacent bony margins. Involvement of the medial aspect of the knee joint is much more common than of the lateral compartment. The anteroposterior projection of the knee on the right shows narrowing of the lateral compartment and sclerosis of adjacent bony margins. The intercondylar tibial tubercles are elongated, and there is flattening of the medial femoral condyle. Unicompartamental joint space loss and reactive new bone formation help differentiate degenerative from inflammatory arthritis.
